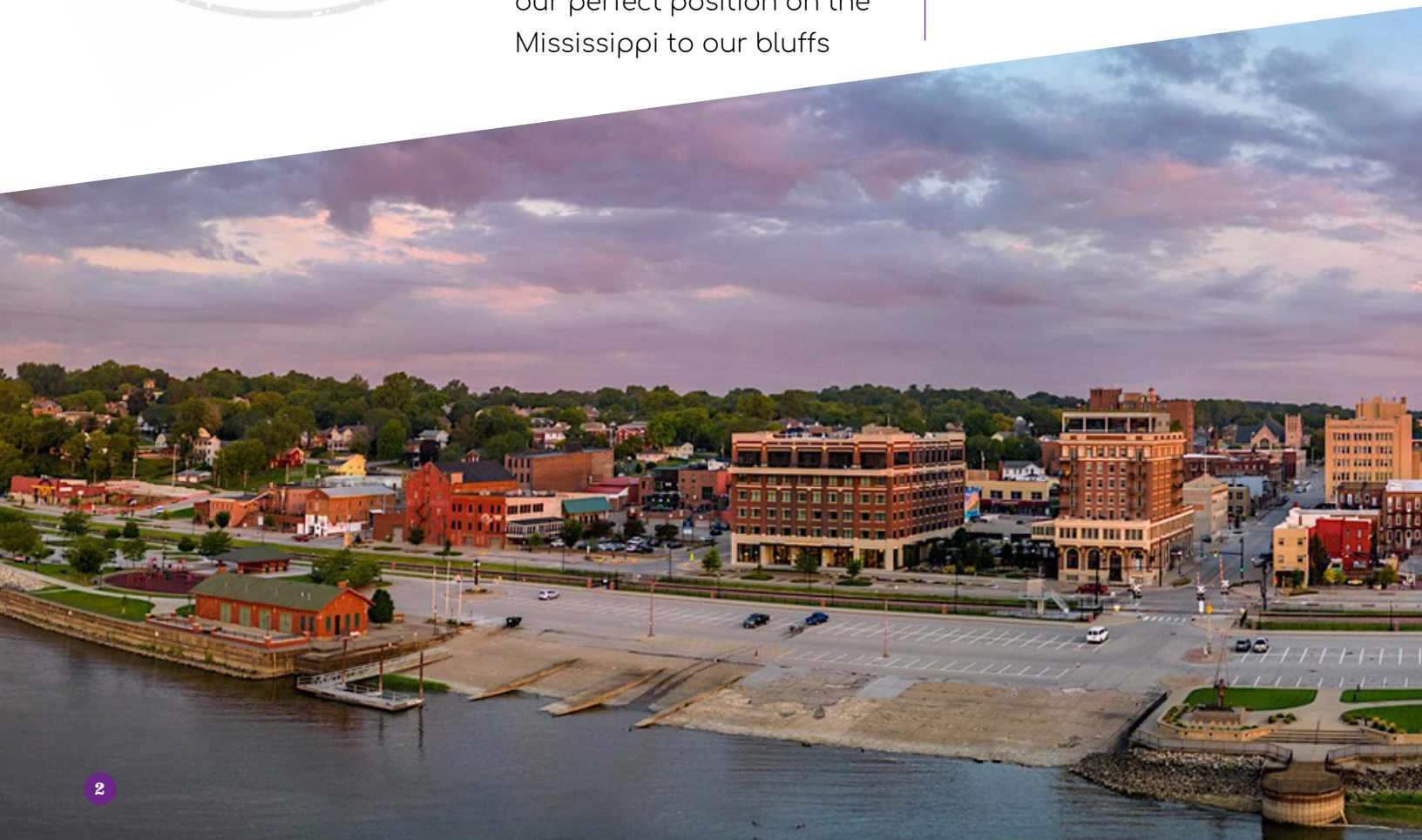

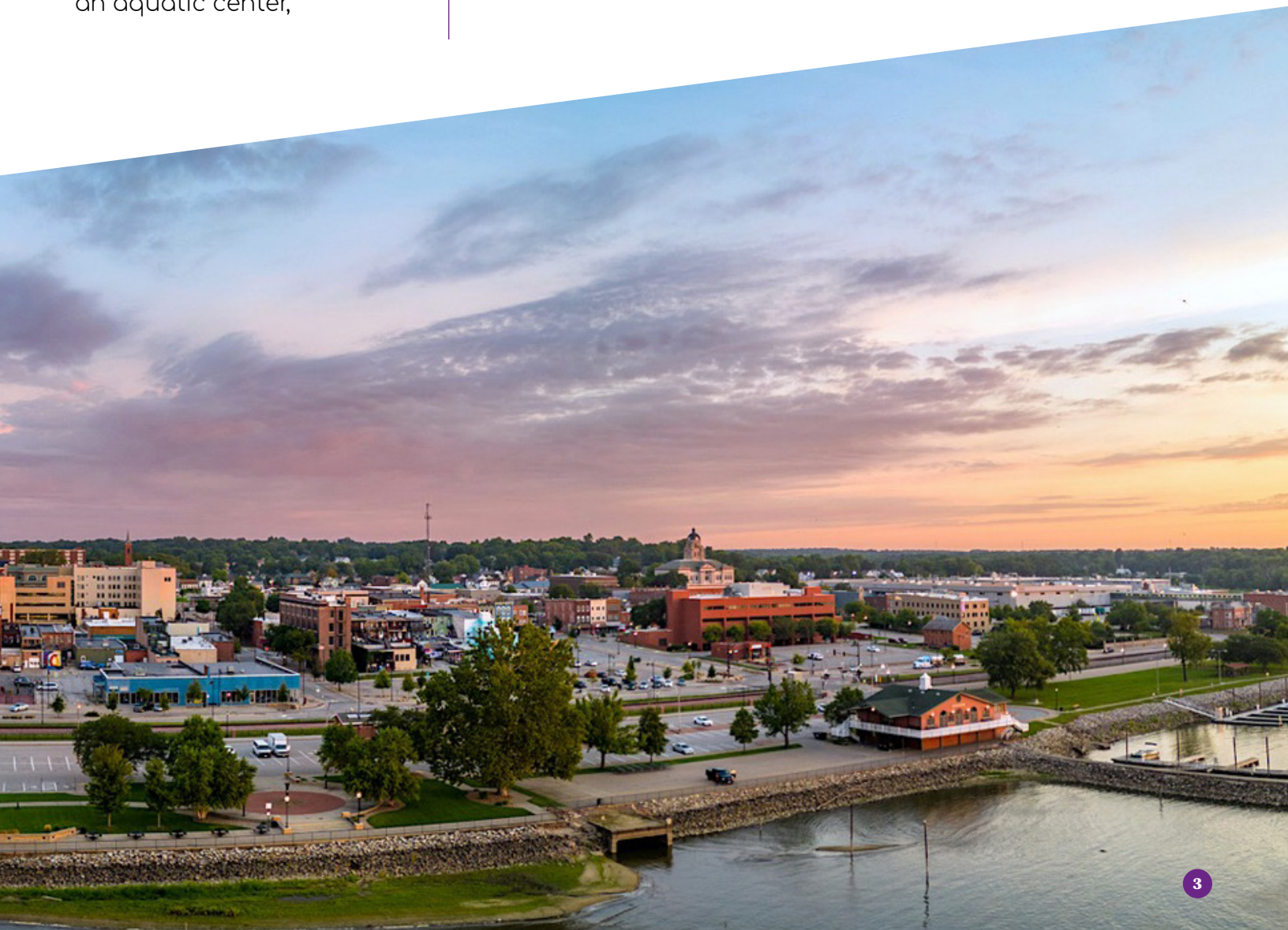

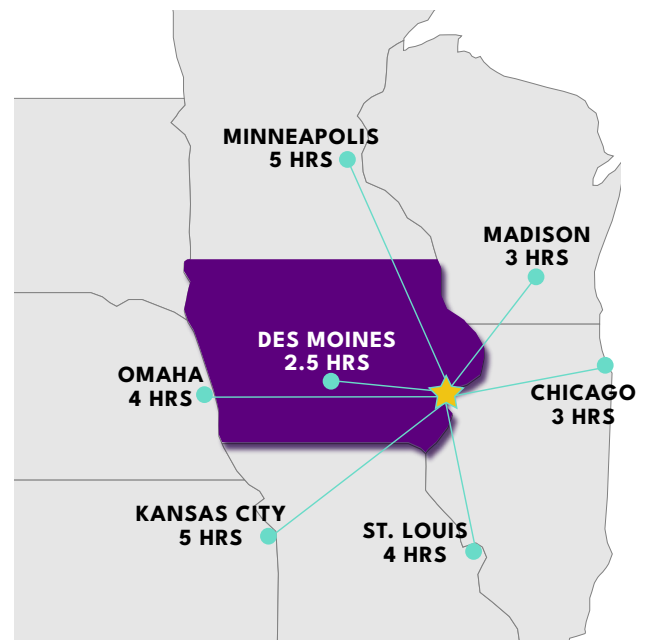

## CIVIL WAR MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

At the beginning of the Civil War in 1861, Muscatine men hurried to enlist. Muscatine sent more men to war than any other county in Iowa. Later, in April of 1862, the casualty list from the Battle of Shiloh in Tennessee touched every neighborhood in the city. For 50 years, the city celebrated Shiloh Day. Muscatine still remembers the Civil War. Monuments and markers can be found in different parts of the county:

# Sports & Recreation



Muscatine is home to an abundance of recreational facilities that are perfect for individuals and families alike. From the riverfront bike and pedestrian path to wooded trails, Muscatine County has a variety of ways to enjoy recreation in the area.

## Deep Lakes Park

Fish, canoe, kayak, hike, explore and more at Deep Lakes Park. This 435-acre park, donated to Muscatine County by longtime sand and gravel business W.G. Block, is still referred to by locals as “the sand pits” and includes 130 acres of fishable water, and numerous small lakes and ponds, with the largest lake totaling 55 acres.

Amenities and facilities include parking lots, a swimming beach (open Memorial Day Weekend), restrooms, a boat ramp on Lake Chester and Lake Jewel as well as access for canoes, kayaks and small boats. For cabin reservations or boat rentals call the Muscatine County Conservation Office.

## Musco Sports Center

The MUSCO Sports Center is the next BIG hit in Muscatine. With a combination soccer, football, and 2 baseball/softball fields, the MUSCO Sports Center is ready for your next sporting event! Inside includes restrooms, concessions stand, seating, and six indoor pickleball courts for reservation.

### Kent-Stein Park

Kent-Stein Park is a 66-acre home run of a sports complex. The park has eight lighted baseball diamonds (including historic Tom Bruner Field), nine lighted softball diamonds, batting cages, nine lighted horseshoe courts, two concession stands, picnic areas, restroom facilities, walking/biking trails and fishing in the adjoining 11-acre slough.

The park hosts events sponsored by national, state and local associations involving participants of all ages. Tournaments, camps, clinics, games and practices are welcome.

### Muscatine Aquatic Center

## Muscatine Skate Park

## Muscatine Soccer Complex

This complex is a 41-acre, \$3.8 million facility that has earned national recognition, being named “Best Soccer Facility” by the National Turf Grass Managers Association. With eight full-sized state-of-the-art premier soccer fields — and two of the eight internationally sized and lighted with amended soils — this facility welcomes about 100,000

visitors annually. The complex also hosts events sponsored by national, state and local associations involving participants of all ages. Camps, clinics, games and tournaments are welcome.

The complex is fully equipped, including concessions, media center, restrooms and a parking area.

## Weed Park & Zoo Garden

You'll find plenty of room to roam at historic Weed Park, which covers 72 acres, including a 3-acre lagoon. Here, you'll also find the Muscatine Aquatic Center, fishing pond, picnic areas, seven shelters, playground equipment, restrooms, a rose garden, 8 tennis courts (four lighted) and three lighted sand volleyball courts.

Weed Park is also home to the Zoo Garden — a garden that features animal sculptures, gardens, kiosks and trails that bring to life the spirit of the live-animal zoo that was once located there.

the way. While always stunning, the park is especially beautiful in the fall when the leaves are turning.

While at Wildcat Den, take a moment to step into life in a small frontier town by visiting Melpine Schoolhouse and Pine Creek Grist Mill. Also, don't forget

to check out the Old Stone Church just outside of the park. Wildcat Den also has modern camping sites and picnic areas.

## World's Biggest Watermelon Slice

The World's Largest Watermelon Slice Sculpture is a vibrant structure celebrating Muscatine's agricultural roots. It measures a whopping 40 feet long, stands 26 feet high, and weighs 16,000 pounds. Located along the riverfront path, the sculpture is the perfect photo-op stop!

Located along the Mississippi River, Muscatine offers many interesting attractions. No matter if you are looking for a day trip or weekend getaway, there is something for everyone.

### Bayer Butterfly Garden

Open to the public, the Bayer Butterfly Garden attracts many pollinators with an array of brightly colored flowers and shrubs that bloom from early spring until fall. Plant employees planted 65 acres of native grasses and wildflowers with the assistance of the Muscatine County Conservation Board in 1993 and an additional 90 acres were added to the prairie in 1998, including a butterfly garden.

Enjoy a picnic at the tables or relax in the gazebo as a pond with dual waterfalls attracts birds and koi swim through the water lilies.

## Discovery Park and Environmental Learning Center

Walk or bike the 2 miles of paved trails, 1.5 miles of mowed trails, fish from the stocked ponds, stop by the outdoor raptor enclosure or visit the Environmental Learning Center all in the 100-acre natural park in an urban environment.

The Environmental Learning Center offers numerous natural history exhibits, two 1,200-gallon aquariums with native fish, live reptiles and amphibians, more than 100 mounted animals and is the home to the Muscatine County Conservation Board office.

The classroom in the Environmental Learning Center is available for rental by organized groups or businesses for workshops and meetings.

## Fairport Fish Hatchery

Located 8 miles east of Muscatine on Highway 22 and The Great River Road. With 18 ponds, this facility hatches and grows largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, Northern pike and bluegill to stock in Iowa lakes. Walleye are raised for stocking Iowa's interior rivers.

The hatchery was established in 1908 and started out as a freshwater mussel research and propagation station to contribute to the local pearl button industry. It became a fish hatchery in 1929. Self-guided and educational tours available.

## Great River Road

The Great River Road is a collection of state and local roads that follow the course of the Mississippi River through 10 states from Ontario to the Gulf of Mexico. Developed in 1938, the road is 2,340

miles designated with a green-and-white sign showing a river steamboat inside a pilot wheel with the name of the state or province. Muscatine holds a special fondness for the Great River Road as one of our own, Charles

H. Young, worked toward establishing the Great River Road and according to some, the idea for the green and white pilot wheel marker distinguishing the route is attributed to Young.

Take a moment to enjoy the view at the Mark Twain Overlook (100-198 Lombard St) located by the entrance to the Norbert F. Beckey Bridge near downtown Muscatine. Here you can find signage dedicated to Charles H. Young's work toward establishing the Great River Road.

## Norbert F. Beckey Bridge

After enjoying the beautiful river views in the daylight, be sure to take a look at the Norbert F. Beckey Bridge — the first bridge over the Mississippi River with LED lights.

Completed in December 1972, it replaced the Muscatine High Bridge, which stood from 1891-1973. A pillar from the old High Bridge still stands at Riverside Park in Muscatine. The bridge, which stretches 1,500 feet from Iowa to Illinois, across the Mississippi River, is awash in a rainbow of colors. Lighting the night, the color array can be changed for specific events and holidays. Mark Twain might have seen his most beautiful sunsets in Muscatine, but modern residents and visitors to this historic river town now have their own light show to enjoy.

## Muscatine Arboretum

Take a walk with your four-legged friends and look at more than 1,000 native and ornamental trees and shrubs that have been planted, mulched and labeled. Paved trails wind throughout these 15-acres located adjacent to Discovery Park. In addition to the beautiful trees and plantings, you can also enjoy a Veterans Memorial Area, a medieval style brick labyrinth, a gazebo (perfect for picnics) and many benches to sit and enjoy your surroundings!

## Muscatine Art Center

Built in 1908, the Laura Musser Mansion, part of the Muscatine Art Center, provides an elegant setting for the display of fine and decorative arts. The mansion's hallways feature an impressive collection of works by artists such as Renoir, Degas, Chagall and Pissarro. Period rooms blend family furnishings with paintings that depict the Mississippi River. Linked to the original mansion is the Stanley Gallery which provides two floors of space for changing exhibitions. Located on the grounds is a historic Japanese Garden installed in 1930.

Walk-in visitors are welcome Tuesday through Sunday with admission by

donation. Muscatine Art Center staff offers educational programs and group tours for children and adults.

## National Pearl Button Museum @ The History and Industry Center

Explore the industry which made Muscatine the “Pearl Button Capital of the World.” Learn about innovators like John Boepple, who cut the first buttons in Muscatine in 1891, and the entrepreneurs whose companies made 1.5 billion buttons per year. Consider the lives of the workers who harvested mussels, labored in the factories, and organized unions to fight for better working conditions. Study the mussels — the amazing creatures which made all this possible.

On the second level of the museum, learn how Muscatine has become a thriving manufacturing center, led by industrial giants of the 1940s and 50s who pioneered the production of office furniture, retread tires, and corn by-products. ### Land of the Swamp White Oak Preserve

The White Oak Swamp, the Red Cedar Woodland, and Greiner Family Preserves are three Muscatine County natural areas that are part of The Nature Conservancy, an international organization whose mission is "to conserve the lands and waters on which all life depends." These preserves are a wonderland for naturalists. The 654-acre White Oak Swamp Preserve is habitat for an estimated 500 plant species as well as some endangered animal species. The very unique 34-acre Red Cedar Woodland Preserve is found on an island in the Cedar River and can only be reached by boat or by wading through water. The 117-acre Greiner Family Nature Preserve is a sand prairie and wetland area, hosting a unique combination of soil and water essential to nesting turtles also supporting an assemblage of rare plants and animals.

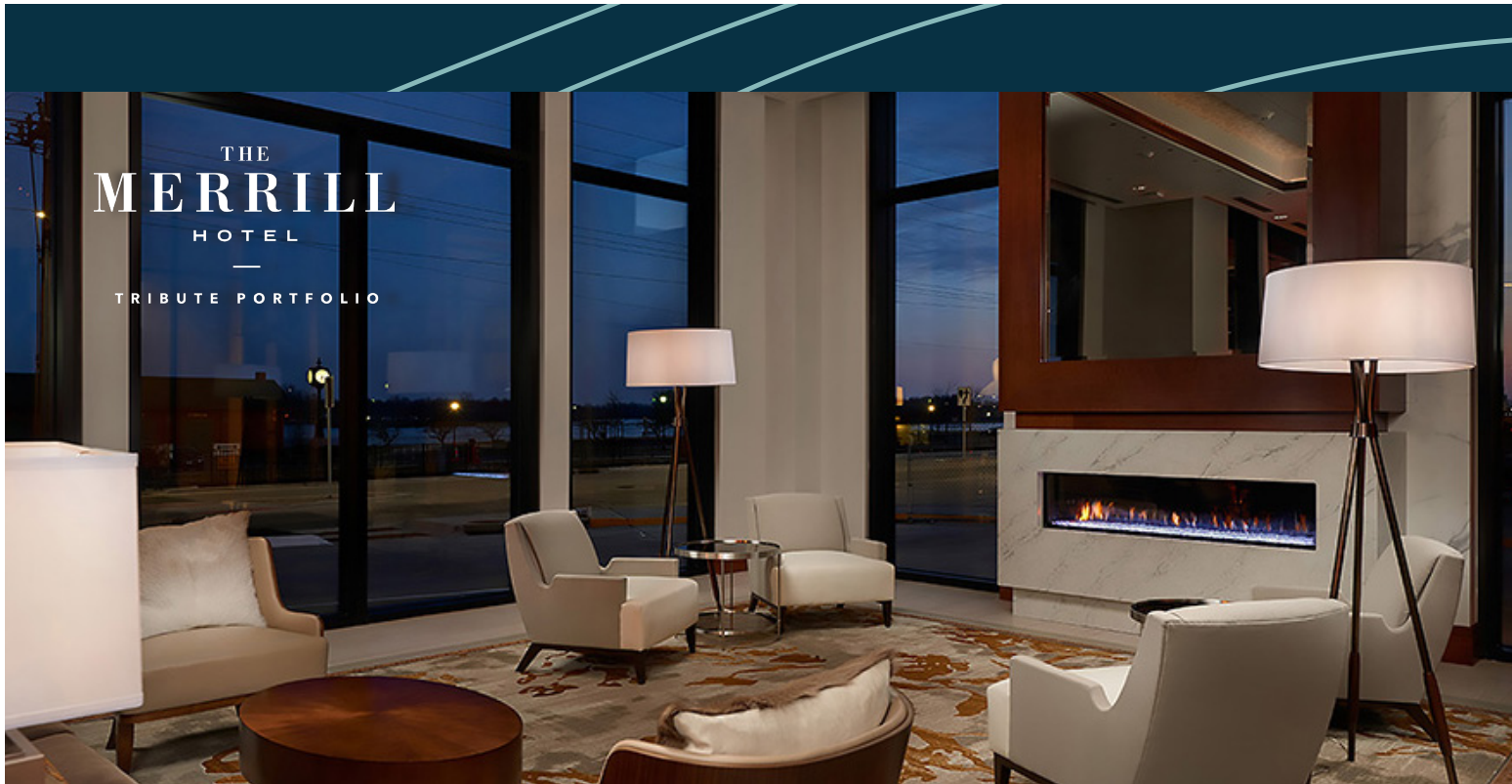

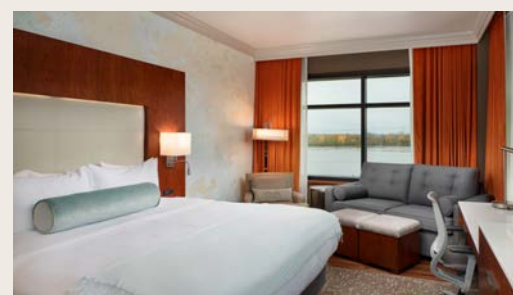
